Safe Bicycling Tips

- Always wear a helmet when you ride a bike and make sure to wear it correctly. Your helmet should be ANSI or SNELL approved.
- Stop at all intersections. Always walk your bike across busy intersections and streets.
- 3. Always ride your bike on the right with traffic.
- Make sure you obey traffic signs, signals and pavement markings.
 Make a complete stop at all stop signs.
- Stop and make sure the roadway is clear before entering from a sidewalk or driveway.
- 6. Always use proper hand signals when turning or stopping.
- 7. Avoid riding at night.
- 8. Give the right-of-way to pedestrians.
- Pay careful attention to what is happening around you. Watch for opening car doors and other traffic hazards.
- 10. Do everything you can to make sure motorists see you. For example, wear light or bright colored clothing and install safety flags, reflectors and/or lights on your bike.
- 11. Use bike paths and lightly traveled streets when you can.
- 12. Keep your bike in good repair.
