> Take charge of your child's safety.

If your child is under age 8 , he or she needs more than a seat belt to be safe in a vehicle. Is your child protected?

Seat belts are made for adults...car seats help them work for children. Until your child is about age 8 , and $4^{\prime} 9$ " tall, a car seat is needed to keep him or her safe. The back seat is the safest place for children under age 13.
